- 1. An archer can win one individual award only per section; the organisers reserve the right to adjust awards according to entries.

- 4. Record Status shoots will be liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply; refusal will be treated as a positive result. Juniors' entry forms must be signed by a parent or guardian to signify their consent to their child being tested if approached.
- 5. Recurve and longbow archers will be integrated and shoot on full size single 60cm faces. Pairs of compound archers will share a 3-spot face, each spot will be similar to the full size face but with just the 10 to 6 scoring zones present. One arrow each at each spot with arrows outside the allocated face recorded as misses.
- 6. cold snacks and drinks available.
- 7. Smoking is prohibited in the main hall.
- 8. The hall is equipped with backstop netting; the organisers cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to equipment or personal possessions.
- 9. The results will be posted for five minutes for objections before the presentation, after which no alterations will be made.
- 10. A surcharge of £2 per entry will be payable for any entries accepted after the closing date.
