FITA 70/60m to consist of 72 arrows at 70/60 metres (122 cm FITA Face) and 50m Compound to consist of 72 arrows at 50m (80cm five zone scoring FITA Face) in ends of 6 arrows to prevailing FITA timing shooting in 2 details with 4 archers to a boss.

This event is held to provide the opportunity for archers to gain Target awards, UK Ranking and Qualification scores. There will be a limited presentation following the end of the second session.

Session 1 - Assembly: 08:30, Practice 08:45 – 09:30, Start 09:30

Session 2 - Assembly: 12:45, Practice 13:00 – 13:45, Start 13:45

Session 2 timings are dependent on session 1 completion but will not be before the stated times.

FITA and GNAS rules apply to this competition appropriate to the format of the round being shot. It is a condition of entry and admission to the venue that all competitors and visitors comply with the reasonable requests of the Tournament Organiser and Judge in Charge for the safety and comfort of all persons attending.

GNAS dress regulations 307 will apply.

Photography & image recording - the recommendation in the GNAS Protection of Children & Vulnerable Adults Policy will apply. All persons wishing to make recorded images or video have to register with the tournament organiser.

This Record Status Shoot will be liable for drug testing; competitors approached to give samples must comply, as refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents or carers of competitors under the age of 18 must sign the entry form giving consent to a drug test if required.

GNAS Membership cards to be shown on registration, competitors may only shoot with proof of membership.

Entry fees: £12 - Both Rounds/ £6.50 - Single Round, cheques payable to **Welbeck Archers**.

Closing date 21st May 2014 or when fully subscribed. No refunds will be given after this date.
