## Notes

1. All archers must be affiliated to Archery GB or a World Archery member association and will be asked to produce their membership cards when signing in.
2. Please indicate on the entry form if you have a disability that requires any special measures.
3. Archery GB dress regulations as shown in Archery GB Rule 307 will apply.
4. Record Status shoots will be liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply; refusal will be treated as a positive result. Juniors' entry forms must be signed by a parent or guardian to signify their consent to their child being tested if approached.
5. The Target List will be issued on the day. Results lists will be sent in PDF format to those including an email address and will be available on the Bowmen of Rutland website [www.b-o-r.org](http://www.b-o-r.org). Hard copies if absolutely necessary will be sent if a stamped, self-addressed envelope (23cm x 16cm minimum) is included.
6. The organisers cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to equipment or personal possessions.
7. Light refreshments will be available throughout the day.
8. Archery GB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy requires that any persons wishing to engage in any type of photography or videoing must register with the organisers on arrival before carrying out such activity. Whilst every effort will be made to ensure that unauthorised photography does not take place, the Bowmen of Rutland, the organisers and working party cannot be held responsible for breaches of this code. We therefore request that you report any unauthorised photography directly to the organisers.
9. When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club, County, Region, Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability information.
10. Entries to be received by the organisers by 13<sup>th</sup> October 2018.
11. No refunds can be made after the closing date.
12. Each archer must receive instruction in clout shooting prior to the tournament, see Archery GB Rule 700(e). All archers must sign the entry form to confirm this. If necessary, instruction will be given on the day before shooting starts.

## The WA Clout

World Archery only recognises the One-Way Clout for Ladies and Gentlemen.

The distances are:

	<u>Recurve</u>	<u>Compound</u>
Ladies	125 metres (137 yds approx)	165 metres (180 yds approx)
Gentlemen	165 metres (180 yds approx)	185 metres (202 yds approx)

The target area is 15 metres in diameter, divided into 5 concentric scoring zones each measuring 1.5 metres in width. Archers shooting the WA Clout will be eligible for Metric Tassel Awards.

### Juniors

Juniors will shoot a one-way Archery GB Metric Clout. Unless stated otherwise on the entry form, it will be assumed that juniors will shoot the distance appropriate to their ages as indicated in Archery GB Rule 707. There is nothing to prevent a junior shooting the adult round for adult awards only. Juniors shooting the Archery GB Metric Clout will be eligible for Metric Tassel Awards.
