Notes:

- Record Status** - As this is a Record Status Tournament AGB dress regulations (Rule 307) apply. Record Status Tournaments are liable for drug testing; competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. It is a requirement of Record Status Events that parents/guardians of juniors must sign the entry form to give consent for drug testing.
- AGB** - All archers must be affiliated to ArcheryGB and will be asked to produce their membership cards when signing in.
- Scoring** - Five-zone scoring will be used for this shoot and so the 'odds & evens' rule applies. Impossible scores will not be accepted.
- Handicaps** - Please declare a handicap on your entry form. There are several handicap awards for un-rewarded on the day EMAS archers. EMAS archers who do not declare their handicap will not be eligible for Handicap Awards
- Arrows** - Please note that all arrows must be accounted for, as such archers wishing to use arrows that are not metal detector responsive i.e. all carbon, are requested to identify their equipment with the judges before the commencement of the shoot and again on departure.
- Photography** - In compliance with Archery GB Safeguarding guidelines any person wishing to engage in any form of photography or video must register with the Tournament Organiser.
- Refreshments** – Tea and Coffee will be available throughout the day. Please bring your own mug.
- Wheelchair archers** - please state whether right or left handed.
- Cancellations** – No refunds will be given for cancellations after the closing date.
- Disclaimer** - Please note: EMAS and Wellingborough Open Archery Club do not accept any liability for personal injury, loss or damage to competitor's equipment or possessions however so caused.
- Data Protection** – When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth/age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), round (unless defined by age) Disabled (Y/N) Disability information.
