#### All Awards According to Entries

#### Special Note

If an archer shoots more than one session, it will be the first round scored that is used for the results and championships.

#### General Notes

1. An archer can win one individual award only per section; the organisers reserve the right to adjust awards according to entries.
2. All archers must be affiliated to Archery GB or a World Archery member organisation & will be asked to produce their membership cards when signing in.
3. AGB dress regulations as shown in AGB Rule 307 will apply, archers must wear plain green/white or officially registered alternative shooting colours. Soft soled shoes are to be worn.
4. Record Status shoots will be liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply; refusal will be treated as a positive result. Juniors' entry forms must be signed by a parent or guardian to signify their consent to their child being tested if approached.
5. Recurve, Barebow and longbow archers will be integrated and shoot on full size single 60cm faces. Pairs of compound archers will share a 3-spot face, each spot will be similar to the full size face but with just the 10 to 6 scoring zones present. One arrow each at each spot with arrows outside the allocated face recorded as misses.
6. Refreshments available.
7. Smoking is prohibited on campus.
8. The hall is equipped with backstop netting; the organisers cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to equipment or personal possessions.
9. The results will be posted for five minutes for objections before the presentation, after which no alterations will be made.
10. A surcharge of £2 per entry will be payable for any entries accepted after the closing date.
11. No money will be refunded after the closing date.
12. Under the provisions within the Archery GB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event are to register with the organisers on arrival. Whilst every effort will be made to ensure that unauthorised photography does not take place, L&RCAA, the organisers and working party cannot be held responsible for breaches of this code. We therefore request that you report any unauthorised photography directly to the organisers.
