Archers should be fully familiar with WA Timing, Signals and Bouncer procedures.

- Awards:1st, 2nd 3rd awards for Recurve and compound according to entry. Junior
competition will be ran as a mixed gents / ladies tournament.
- Scoring: Please note, archers are responsible for making sure that all aspects of their scoresheet, arrow values, score values, golds, number of hits etc. are correct before signing (rule 306 d).
- Other Details:Foam Bosses available.NO GAZEBO'S, COOKING ONLY ALLOWED OUTSIDE OF ROPED AREA AND
NOT WITHIN 2 METRES OF NEAREST TENT.
- Parking:Please adhere to Parking Attendants for parking your car as cars cannot
be parked on the road. Directions can be obtained from
www.bowmenofglen.org
- Smoking:At all times, smoking is prohibited on the Field of Play. The "Field of Play"
is defined as the shooting area, including all required overshoot, and all
areas behind the shooting line extending to a point at least five metres
beyond the last archer's tent or shelter.s

- **Drug Testing:** The World Record Status Shoot will be liable for drug testing. Competitors approached to give samples must comply as refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents/legal guardians of competitors under the age of 18 must sign the entry form giving consent to drug testing if required.
