



L&R 300 Notes – March 2016

FULL COMPETITION RESULTS ON SEPARATE SHEET

Juniors

There were 34 junior archers shooting the L&R 300 during March, with 2 shooting the round for the first time.

Personal Bests (PBs) were shot by 5 juniors during March, 1 junior shot a PB for the 3rd consecutive month – Holly Seaton. Well done all of you.

Most improved archers of the month for March are Megan Taylor who improved on her PB by 29 points and Holly Seaton who improved on her PB by 28 points.

Holly Seaton was also the most improved junior archer of the season, improving on PB from the start of the season by an impressive 131 points.

During the 2015-16 season we had a total of 55 junior archers who shot the round, this is just 1 less than the 2014-15 season.

Seniors

There were 123 senior archers shooting the L&R 300 during March. 7 seniors shot the round for the first time, although there were a few who have previously shot the round but didn't manage to shoot it during the month possibly due to preparing for the outdoor season.

PBs were shot by 32 seniors, with 4 seniors shooting a PB for the 2nd consecutive month, 1 senior shooting a PB for the 3rd consecutive month and 2 seniors shooting a PB for the 4th consecutive month.

During the 2015-16 season we had a total of 219 senior archers who shot the round, this is an increase of 48 archers with 171 senior archers shooting the round during the 2014-15 season.

I hope you are all enjoyed shooting the round, especially those juniors & seniors new to the competition. Hopefully even more will take part next season.
