Juniors

December / January has seen 4 new juniors shooting the L&R300 for the first time.

The round was shot by 37 juniors overall which is an increase of 6 from November.

Personal Bests (PB) were shot by 13 juniors, including by 3 archers who achieved a PB for the second time on consecutive months.

Junior Archer of the Month goes to Daniel Smith from Ivanhoe AC who beat his previous PB by 69. Well done Daniel!

Ivanhoe A Team remain on the top spot in the team competition with Kirby Muxloe A Team a close second.

The round was shot by 134 Seniors which is a decrease of 2 on last month.

PB's were shot by 31 seniors, which included 6 archers who achieved a PB for the second consecutive month. November saw 3 archers shoot this competition for the first time.

In the team competition, Fosse Company of Archers A team and Bowmen of Rutland A Team share the top spot. Only 23 points separate the top 4 places.
