## Master Round

Ladies/Gents may compete in the year of his/her 50<sup>th</sup> birthday and thereafter. Gents may shoot a Ladies FITA and Ladies may shoot a Metric II and still be able to claim World Records.

## Notes

FITA also recognise Cadets; Cadet girls who choose to shoot the Metric II and Cadet Boys who choose to shoot the Metric I are eligible for FITA Star (Cadet) Star Awards.

In line with the published changes to the Rules of Shooting, note that the Metric V round distances have been changed and are now championship status for Girls only.

- In view of the provisions of the Archery GB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event are to register with the Tournament Organiser on Arrival. No unauthorised photography will be permitted.
- The Record Status Shoot will be liable for drug testing; competitors approached to give samples must comply as refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents or Carers of competitors under the age of 18 must sign the entry form giving consent to drug testing if required.

- Stamped addressed envelope required for printed results sheet. If you would also like score sheets mailing to you please list all archers' names on the back of the SAE.
