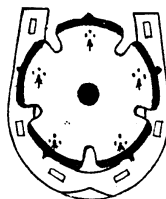
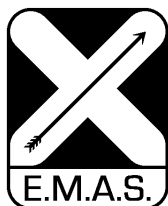

All these awards and others will be according to entry.

Notes

1. All archers must be affiliated to GNAS or a FITA member association and will be asked to produce their membership cards when signing in.
2. GNAS dress regulations as shown in GNAS Rule 307 will apply, archers must wear plain green/white or officially registered alternative shooting colours.
3. Record Status shoots will be liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply; refusal will be treated as a positive result. Juniors' entry forms must be signed by a parent or guardian to signify their consent to their child being tested if approached.
4. The Target List will be issued on the day. Results lists will be sent in PDF format to those including an email address and will be available on the County website www.lrcaa.org. Hard copies if absolutely necessary will be sent if a stamped, self-addressed envelope (23cm x 16cm minimum) is included.
5. The organisers cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to equipment or personal possessions.
6. Light refreshments will be available throughout the day.
7. Under the provisions within the GNAS Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event are to register with the organisers on arrival. Whilst every effort will be made to ensure that unauthorised photography does not take place, EMAS, L&RCAA, the organisers and working party cannot be held responsible for breaches of this code. We therefore request that you report any unauthorised photography directly to the organisers.
8. Entries to be received by the organisers by 14th October 2007.
9. No refunds can be made after the closing date.
10. Each archer must receive instruction in clout shooting prior to the tournament, see GNAS Rule 700. All archers must sign the entry form to confirm this. If necessary, instruction will be given on the day before shooting starts.

The FITA Clout

The essential differences from a GNAS Clout are given below.

FITA only recognise the One-Way Clout for Ladies and Gentlemen.

The distances are:

	<u>Recurve</u>	<u>Compound</u>
Ladies	125 metres (137 yds approx)	165 metres (180 yds approx)
Gentlemen	165 metres (180 yds approx)	185 metres (202 yds approx)

The target area is 15 metres in diameter, divided into 5 concentric scoring zones each measuring 1.5 metres in width. This is much bigger than the GNAS Clout target.

Juniors

As FITA do not recognise junior rounds, juniors will shoot a one-way GNAS Clout. Unless stated otherwise on the entry form, it will be assumed that juniors will shoot the distance appropriate to their ages as indicated in GNAS Rule 705(b). There is nothing to prevent a junior shooting the adult round for adult awards only. Juniors shooting the GNAS Clout will be eligible for Tassel Awards.
