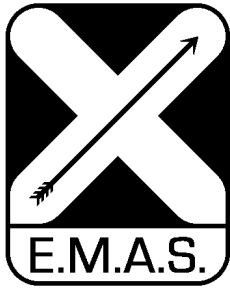

It is a requirement of Record Status Events that parents/guardians of juniors must sign the entry form to give consent for drug testing.

Double scoring (with two score cards) will be employed. Five-zone scoring will be used for this shoot and so the ‘odds & evens’ rules applies. Impossible scores will not be accepted.

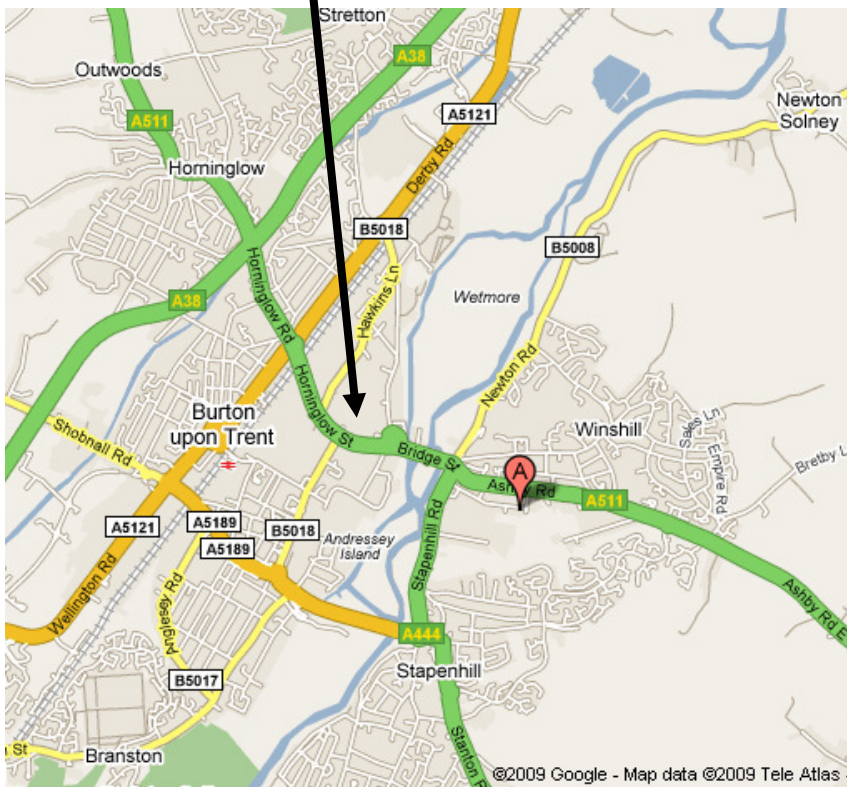
