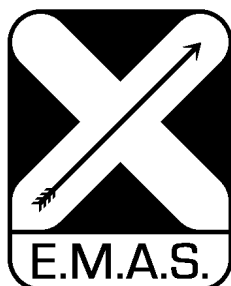

Dress Regulations

As this is a Record Status Tournament GNAS dress regulations (Rule 307) apply, i.e. competitors must be dressed in plain dark green and/or white or registered Club colours.

Drug Testing

Record Status Tournaments are liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result.

The entry form must be signed by a parent or guardian to signify their consent to their child being tested if approached. Clubs / Parents / Guardians must explain the implications of drug testing to young archers and vulnerable persons.

Photography

In view of the provisions of the GNAS Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults policy, those wishing to take photographs at this event are to register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival. **No** unauthorised photography will be allowed.

Scoring

Double scoring (with two score cards) will be employed. Five zone scoring will be used for this shoot and so the 'odds & evens' rules applies. Impossible scores will not be accepted.

Handicaps

Please declare a handicap on your entry form. There are several handicap awards for unrewarded EMAS archers.

DUE TO THE FIELD BEING USED FOR THE PLAYING OF RUGBY, THE ONLY ARROWS ALLOWED TO BE SHOT WILL BE THOSE THAT CAN BE DETECTED ALONG THEIR ENTIRE LENGTH BY A METAL DETECTOR. **NO ALL CARBON ARROWS WILL BE ALLOWED.** WOODEN SHAFTED ARROWS SHOT FROM A LONGBOW WILL BE PERMITTED
