Please note that the Metric V and Bristol V rounds are non-Record status and archers shooting these rounds are not eligible for awards. Certificates will be presented. Dress rules still apply.

This event is open to any Junior member of GNAS or of a FITA Member Association.
Only a GNAS member who is a British National may be the holder of a British National Championship.

Dress: GNAS dress regulations as shown in GNAS Rule 307 will apply. Archers must wear plain dark green / white or officially registered alternative shooting colours. Competitors in the Home Nations Match are permitted to wear their National colours.

Age Limits: The ages are as on the day of competition. An archer may enter a round in a higher age group than their own, but not for a lower age group.

Rules: The tournament will be run to the current GNAS/FITA rules. The Metric Rounds will be shot in timed ends of six arrows at the two longer distances and in timed ends of three arrows at the two shorter distances.

Photography: In view of the provisions of the GNAS Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event are to register with the Tournament Secretary on arrival. No unauthorised photography will be permitted.

Assembly: Saturday – Assembly 9:00 am, followed by 2 ends of practice; the competition continues immediately thereafter. Equipment inspection will be announced. Sunday – Assembly 9:00 am, Sighters 9:30 am.

Entry fee: £10 for one day £18 for two days (cheques payable to 'GNAS' please). No refunds after the closing date.

Drug testing: Record Status shoots are liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse that refusal will be treated as a positive result. The entry form must be signed by a parent or guardian to signify their consent to their child being tested if approached. Parents must explain the implications of drug testing to the younger archers.

Home International: The Home International will be held on the Saturday using a handicap scores system under arrangements made by the Team Managers.

Scoring: Please be aware that the organisers will be looking for volunteers from the parents to help with the scoring.

Refreshments: Light refreshments will be available on site.

Camping/ Caravanning: Camping and caravanning space is available on site of £5.50 per night.

Caravanning: Please add this sum to your entry cheque.
