#### Directions

From the M1 Southbound  
Junction 22 and follow the A50 towards Leicester. Right, on to the A46 back towards the M1/M69 and take the first exit off (non-motorway traffic) follow the signs for Kirby Muxloe. On entering the village, straight over both roundabouts then immediate right turn into Sports club.

From the M1 Northbound  
Junction 21a, and take the A46 slip road off the exit road off the M1, first exit to Kirby Muxloe. Follow the signs to the village, straight over both roundabouts and immediate right into Sport Club.

From the A46  
Follow the signs to Kirby Muxloe, the last junction before you join the M1 south, On entering the village, straight over both roundabouts and immediate right turn into the sports club

Camping/Caravanning is permitted on site. Fresh water, toilets and basic showers are available. There is also a bar in the Sports club

                  2 nights £5 per tent/caravan

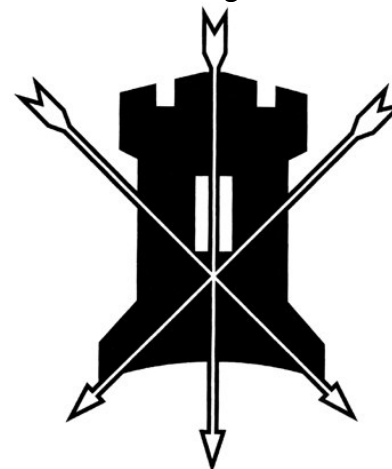

Please note that photographs may only be taken with the consent of the subject and the Tournament Organiser. Photography at the tournament may be banned if a parent does not want their child photographed. Please respect this request.

This is a Record Status event therefore the current GNAS dress rule must be observed by all competitors.

*Please book in at reception when you arrive, failure to do so may mean that your place is reallocated if the tournament is full and archers turn up on the day.*

**GNAS cards will be checked when booking in, so please have your card ready**

## Shooting

At 90/70m and 70/60m archers will shoot 3 doz. at each distance with ends of 6 arrows in 4 minutes

At 50m & 30m archers will shoot 3 doz. at each distance with ends of 3 arrows in 2 minutes

Inspection of equipment will take place during the 45mins practise
