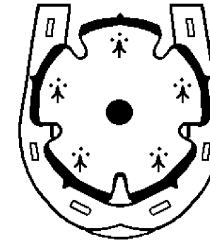

SPECIAL NOTE

Archers wishing to shoot the Single Portsmouth only, must shoot **Session B**.
Archers wishing to shoot the Double Portsmouth must shoot **Sessions A and C**.
Sessions A and B form the County Championships.

GENERAL NOTES

1. An archer can win one individual award only per section; the organisers reserve the right to adjust awards according to entries.
2. All archers must be affiliated to GNAS or a FITA member organisation & will be asked to produce their membership cards when signing in.
3. GNAS dress regulations as shown in GNAS Rule 307 will apply, archers must wear plain green/white or officially registered alternative shooting colours. Soft soled shoes are to be worn.
4. Record Status shoots will be liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply; refusal will be treated as a positive result. Juniors' entry forms must be signed by a parent or guardian to signify their consent to their child being tested if approached.
5. Recurve and longbow archers will be integrated and shoot on full size single 60cm faces. Compound archers will shoot on their own face, which will be similar to the full size face but with the 5 to 1 scoring zones removed, leaving just the 10 to 6 scoring zones (i.e. similar to one element of a three spot face); arrows outside the allocated face will be scored as a miss.
6. Cooked food, cold snacks and Bar available.
7. Smoking and bar drinks are prohibited in the main hall.
8. The hall is not equipped with backstop netting; the organisers cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to equipment or personal possessions.
9. The results will be posted for five minutes for objections before the presentation, after which no alterations will be made.
10. A surcharge of £2 per entry will be payable for any entries accepted after the closing date.
11. No money will be refunded after the closing date.
12. Under the provisions within the GNAS Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event are to register with the organisers on arrival. Whilst every effort will be made to ensure that unauthorised photography does not take place, L&RCAA, the organisers and working party cannot be held responsible for breaches of this code. We therefore request that you report any unauthorised photography directly to the organisers.
