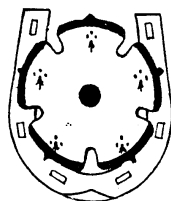

Notes

1. All archers must be affiliated to GNAS or a FITA Member Association and will be asked to produce their membership cards when signing in.
2. GNAS dress regulations as shown in GNAS Rule 307 will apply; archers must wear plain green/white or officially registered alternative shooting colours.
3. Record Status shoots will be liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply; refusal will be treated as a positive result. Juniors' entry forms must be signed by a parent or guardian to signify their consent to their child being tested if approached.
4. Target and Results lists will be sent by email to those including an email address and will be available on the County website www.lrcaa.org. Hard copies will be sent if stamped, self-addressed envelopes (23cm x 16cm minimum) are included.
5. The results will be posted for five minutes for objection before the presentation, after which no alterations will be made.
6. The organisers cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to equipment or personal possessions.
7. Light refreshments will be available throughout the day.
8. Under the provisions within the GNAS Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event are to register with the organisers on arrival.
