Awards:

Awards subject to number of entrants for each category. No awards are given to archers shooting rounds out of category or age group.

Please note:

Record Status has been granted for this event, competitors must comply with GNAS dress regulations - rule 307.

Record Status tournaments are liable for drug testing; competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal to comply will be treated as a positive result. It is a requirement of Record Status events that parents/guardians of juniors entering the York/Hereford/Bristol rounds must sign the entry form to give consent for drug testing.

Under the provisions within the GNAS Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event are to register with the Tournament Secretary on arrival. Whilst every effort will be made to ensure that unauthorised photography does not take place, GNAS, the Tournament Secretary and working party cannot be held responsible for breaches of this code.
