Privacy Policy

The new General Data Protection Regulation replaced the Data Protection Act 1998 and came into force in the UK on 25 May 2018.

This notice explains how we collect and use the personal information about you.

Leicestershire and Rutland County Archery Association (L&RCAA) has access to the Archery GB (AGB) membership portal, where the information you have given to AGB is stored and may include; your name, date of birth, postal address, email address, phone number, a personal description, disability, ethnicity, your archery qualifications, award history or CRB / DBS / PVG checks that have been undertaken and a photograph.

The L&RCAA Secretary has access to this database for the purposes of communicating with you regarding archery business and to allow L&RCAA to manage the running of the sport in our area.

Your name, AGB number, date of birth, sex and club membership are collated into reports by AGB for the L&RCAA Secretary, which are stored securely.

The L&RCAA Secretary may contact you by email/post about your affiliation payments to L&RCAA and Region (EMAS), which you must pay as part of your affiliation to AGB.

Your email address is recorded in a L&RCAA contacts list if you are a direct AGB member, an officer of a club in L&RCAA, a club representative on the L&RCAA committee, or a L&RCAA officer. This is for the purposes of communicating archery business (and or affiliations). This list is held by the L&RCAA Secretary and Minutes Secretary. Your contact information will be reviewed annually after the L&RCAA Annual General Meeting, and if no longer required your contact data will be deleted.
