For rounds WA1440, Metric I and Metric II both compounds and recurves will shoot at individual 6 zone 80 cm faces for

the 2 shortest distances.

For rounds Metric III, Metric IV and Metric V both

compounds and recurves will shoot at 80 cm full faces for

the 2 shortest distances.

Barebow and Longbow archers will shoot at 80 cm full faces

the 2 shortest distances.



RULES

Archers should be fully familiar with WA Timing, Signals and Bouncer procedures. Under WA regulations you can compete in the Cadet Class up to and including the year of your 17th Birthday, Junior Class up to and including the year of your 20th Birthday.

Awards: Recurve, Compound, Longbow & Barebow

Ladies, Gents & Juniors Awards according to entry

Master Round: Ladies/Gents may compete in the year of his/her 50th Birthday and

thereafter. Gents may compete on a Ladies WA1440 and Ladies may compete on a cadets WA (Metric 2) and still be able to claim World

Records.

Scoring: Please note, archers are responsible for making sure that all aspects of

their scoresheet, arrow values, score values, golds, number of hits etc.

are correct before signing (rule 306 d).

Other Details: Foam Bosses available.

NO GAZEBO'S, COOKING ONLY ALLOWED OUTSIDE OF ROPED AREA AND

NOT WITHIN 2 METRES OF NEAREST TENT.

Parking: Please adhere to Parking Attendants for parking your car as cars cannot

Smoking: At all times, smoking is prohibited on the Field of Play. The "Field of

Play" is defined as the shooting area, including all required overshoot, and all areas behind the shooting line extending to a point at least five

metres beyond the last archer's tent or shelter.s



Target List: A Preliminary Target List will be displayed on the BOGAS website 3 days

before the shoot. Final Target List posted on day, allocated targets

cannot be changed without express approval from the TO.

Handicaps: Changes of handicap must be notified to the organiser before practice to

be eligible for awards.

Drug Testing: The World Record Status Shoot will be liable for drug testing.

Competitors approached to give samples must comply as refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents/legal guardians of competitors under the age of 18 must sign the entry form giving consent to drug

testing if required.




